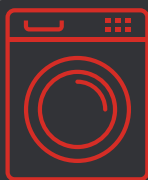


HOW TO PREPARE FOR DRYER VENT CLEANING



Clear Area Around Dryer

Move any items like boxes, clothes, or toys from around the dryer, and sweep the area to provide clear access for the technician.



Unplug the Dryer

Ensure the dryer is fully unplugged, not just turned off, to eliminate any risk of accidental power-up during the technician's work.



Clear Stairs of Obstructions

If your dryer is in the basement, clear the stairs of anything that could obstruct the technician or make transporting equipment difficult.



Locate Dryer Vent

Familiarize yourself with the location and route of the dryer vent so you can guide the technician and avoid unnecessary delays.



Keep Pets Secured

Keep pets in a separate room or area to prevent them from distracting the technician or getting injured in the work zone.



Keep Children Away

Arrange for children to be occupied or out of the house to avoid accidents or interruptions during the cleaning process.



Ensure Parking Availability

Make sure there's a parking spot near your home so the technician can easily access their equipment.



Be Home at Appointment Time

Double-check the appointment time, and be home to greet the technician when they arrive.
