CARBON MONOXIDE LEAK SYMPTOMS

IF CARBON MONOXIDE IS LEAKING INTO YOUR HOME, YOU OR YOUR LOVED ONES MAY EXPERIENCE ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING SYMPTOMS



LETHARGY AND WEAKNESS

Unusual tiredness and difficulty performing daily activities, with persistent exhaustion despite rest.



RESPIRATORY DISTRESS

Difficulty breathing, shortness of breath, and chest pain, with an increased breathing rate.



Sensation of spinning, lightheadedness or a loss of balance - often leading to fainting or falls.



UNEXPLAINED HEADACHES

Persistent or recurrent headaches without a clear cause, varying in intensity and starting suddenly.

RED BLOTCHES ON SKIN

Patchy red discoloration resembling a rash.



LOSS OF CONSCIOUSNESS

Sudden fainting without warning, lasting for varying lengths of time depending on the severity of carbon monoxide exposure.



CONFUSION

Disorientation, difficulty concentrating, and memory problems.

BLURRED VISION

Sudden inability to see clearly, with objects appearing out of focus or hazy.



NAUSEA

Persistent feeling of sickness and an urge to vomit.



EVACUATE IMMEDIATELY

Get everyone out of the house and into fresh air.

CALL 911

Contact your local emergency number to report the suspected carbon monoxide leak.

VENTILATE THE AREA

Open windows & doors to allow fresh air to circulate.
